

Campbell of Monzie Papers XS1 MS A005

A series of documents from 1416 to 1811 of the Campbell family in the Monzie Castle. These documents include correspondence, marriage contracts, petitions, rentals, accounts, inventories, depositions and the like.

1. A letter from Henry Sinclair, Earl of Orkney which appointed David Menzies tutor of his son until his heirs came of age. 11 December 1416
2. An indenture between the Earl and Menzies
3. A series of assignments and discharges dated during the reigns of James VI and Charles I concerning domestic affairs of the Campbell's land transactions.
4. 1592 royal letter
5. Notarial instrument
6. A band
7. 1643 letter from Andrew Murray Lord Balvaird which discusses Scotland's predicament in 1643.
8. The rental accounts detail the names, holdings and rental amounts of the various tenants on the Monzie estates.
9. Early 18th documents relating to Partic Campbell of Monzie, Senator of the College of Justice.
10. Detailed accounts of the African & Indian Company
11. A document of the arguments of Lieutenant-general Alexander Campbell to the Court of Session.
12. Approximately 170 original documents dating from 1416 to 1811.
